


The Crusades: Map Activity



The Crusades: Map Activity

Directions: Complete the following steps in order. Remember to take your time and be neat and accurate with all labeling and coloring.

<u>STEP 1</u> – *Labeling* – Label the following physical features on your map:

- Atlantic Ocean Black Sea
- Mediterranean Sea

<u>STEP 2</u> – *Labeling* – Label the following political features on your map:

- Spain England
- France Holy Roman Empire

STEP 3 – Labeling – Place a dot and label the follow cities (note: Label the cities smaller than you did with steps 1 and 2):

-	Jerusalem	-	Paris
-	Damascus	-	Lisbon
-	Antioch	-	Rome
-	Constantinople	-	Belgrade

<u>STEP 4</u> – *Coloring* – Get *two* different colors. With one of them, *lightly* color the lands under Christian control ("Christian Lands"). Color in the small square next to "Christian Lands" in the legend.

<u>STEP 5</u> – *Coloring* – With the other color, *lightly* color lands under Muslim control ("Muslim Lands"). Again, don't forget to color in the small square next to "Muslim Lands" in the legend.

<u>STEP 6</u> – *Drawing* – Use the maps on pages 327 and 328. Using *four* different colors, *draw in* the routes of each Crusade $(1^{st} - 4^{th})$. When you are finished, the routes of all 4 Crusades should be clearly drawn, each in a different color. Color the 4 boxes in the legend next to the respective Crusade (for example, if you drew the route of the first Crusade in red, color the box next to 1^{st} Crusade red).

STEP 7 – Information – Find the years each Crusade happened. Write the years next to the respective Crusade in the legend.

<u>STEP 8</u> – Information – Under each Crusade (in the legend) there are 3 lines. Your job is to sum up each Crusade in one sentence and write down the sentence on these lines. Give people looking at your map a "snap shot" of that particular Crusade.

STEP 9 – Coloring – After you are finished with everything else, go back and *lightly* color all the water on your paper blue.
